<u>Old Business.</u> 1. Miami Valley Lighting. Mr. James asked if anyone remembered how many lights were supposed to be replaced per our contract with Miami Valley Lighting. They are to replace some of our mercury streetlights with LED lights for \$50.00 per light. Mr. James thought it was aound 72 lights. Our contract is up at the end of 2021.
