Special Council Meeting

September 26,

2017

Attendees: Council Members- Angie Deere, Chris Foster, Gale Honeyman, Alice Beck, Harry McKenna, Gretchen Slagle-Fiscal Officer. Absent-Ed Guess, Ken James. Others Present-Randy Nichols.

Mrs. Beck stated the purpose of the meeting was to discuss village curb painting.

Mrs. Deere noted she wanted to clarify the information about painting the village curbs, since she was not able to be at the last Council meeting. She noted that Mr. McKenna had partially painted Pike St. but it wasn't finished, and it was a different color yellow than the normal safety yellow. Mrs. Deere also knew we had approved \$300 for Randy Nichols to paint Pike Street with the safety yellow paint. Mrs. Deere wanted to look at the laws and guidelines for painting curbs. Randy Nichols has offered to paint Pike Street, he works for a company that does this kind of painting all the time and he has offered to assist us with the rules and guidelines for painting. We currently have approved buying a 5-gallon bucket of paint and have Randy paint the curbs on Pike St. from St. Rt. 571 to the 4-way Stop at Main Street.

Mrs. Deere has asked Randy for a cost for painting curb. Mr. Nichols has an estimate of \$1.50 per foot and estimated a cost of \$500.00 to paint Pike Street. He also has an estimate for other curb painting.

Council discussed if we should paint just Pike Street, paint in front of all fire hydrants, curbs around corners, and paint stop bars. Mr. Foster asked how much stop bars would cost. Mr. Nichols stated \$50.00 each. Mr. Nichols estimated approximately 1250 feet at \$1.50 per foot for a total of \$1882.00 to paint curbs at intersections, at fire hydrants and Pike Street. He said he would include painting stop bars also, for a total of \$2000.00

Mrs. Deere noted that with cold weather coming, if we're going to paint we should try to do it before it gets cold. She also suggested if we were to paint, she would prefer to have everything painted at once.

Mr. McKenna made a motion to have Randy Nichols paint Pike Street, all fire hydrants, curbs at intersections and paint stop bars for a cost of \$2000.00. Mr. Foster seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote: Mrs. Deere -Yes, Mr. Foster-Yes, Mr. Honeyman-Yes, Mrs. Beck-Yes, Mr. McKenna-Yes. The motion passed. Ms. Slagle thought the meeting was going to be a workshop.

Mr. McKenna motioned to close the meeting. Mr. Foster seconded the motion. All yeas, the motion passed.
