She explained the parameters of the grant money, noting 70 percent had to go toward opiod projects/Narcan, etc., 15 percent toward administration fees, and the remaining 15 percent for other uses. Mr. James noted Josh Smith from ODOT has contacted him with concern there are two dead trees that should be removed from along St. Rt. 571. The trees are a hazard and should be removed as soon as possible. Mr. Smith noted we receive State Highway funds that could be used for removing the trees.
